

## **Indian Hammock Preservation Committee**

### **Standard Operating Procedures**

**Purpose:** To serve as an advisory committee to the Board of Directors for the protection and restoration of Indian Hammocks' common areas and waterways to its nature state.

**Organization:** Committee Chairperson is selected by the President of the Board of Directors. Committee Chairperson selects Committee Members. Meetings are held monthly with notice and invitation to attend to membership in advance of meeting. All meetings topics are to be recorded through taken minutes.

#### **Goals:**

- 1) To develop both corrective and conservational programs to be incorporated within the overall maintenance of the common areas by IH Staff.
- 2) Offer guidance to membership as to care of residential lots.

#### **Strategy:**

- 1) Assessment of current condition of waterways and common areas throughout Indian Hammock properties.
- 2) Identify and prioritize areas of need.
- 3) Research and develop corrective and maintenance programs that are environmentally safe for both wildlife and plants
- 4) Develop both short- and long-term conservational programs for maintaining the common areas.
